



Canary Islands Descendants Association of San Antonio (CIDA-SA) 2022 Academic Scholarship Program

WELCOME 2021-2022 SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATES!

OUR PURPOSE: The CIDA mission is to encourage and promote all educational studies as well as historical and genealogical research that enhance the historical, cultural, and civic significance of the accomplishments of the sixteen original Canary Islands families who founded the *Villa de San Fernando*, now the City of San Antonio. <https://cida-sa.org/>. The CIDA Scholarship Program serves as a vehicle to fulfill this purpose by offering monetary scholarships to high school seniors.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: Two scholarships *may* be awarded per year. One \$750 scholarship may be awarded to a CIDA member (including junior members) and one \$500 scholarship to a non-member. If the selections are composed of two CIDA members, then the highest scored applicant will receive \$750 and the second ranking applicant will receive \$500. If the selections are composed of two non-members, then each selected candidate will receive a \$500 scholarship.

AWARD DISTRIBUTION: Scholarships are awarded directly to the student after CIDA receives proof of college registration from the student. College (includes technical college) enrollment in the following academic school year (2022-2023) to retain the award.

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- High school seniors
 - CIDA members from any geographical location (includes Junior members)
 - Nonmember residents in Bexar County and adjacent counties
- Minimum 3.0 GPA or numerical GPA of 83 and submit official high school transcripts
- A fully completed and signed application form
- Essay double spaced, Times New Roman 12pt font and 1" margins
 - **Part 1-** Describe how your academic interest relates to or is inspired by the Canary Islands history, genealogy, culture, or civic significance (500-750 words). See <https://cida-sa.org>
 - **Part 2-** Explain your community service involvement and what you learned.
- Two recommendation letters by educators, clergy or civic leaders who are familiar with the applicant
- You may complete the application electronically, print and mail with the required documentation, or you can print the application and then complete it manually. Please be sure your handwriting is legible.

- Students may start applying immediately
- Students must submit a complete application with essay, recommendation letters and school transcripts and **be postmarked no later than November 15, 2021**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Award recipients will be notified by February 2022.
- Recipients will be announced at the CIDA Arrival Luncheon held in March 2022, and recipients will receive a courtesy ticket to the luncheon.
