

Canary Island Descendants Association of San Antonio (CIDA-SA) 2026 Academic Scholarship Program

WELCOME 2025-2026 SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATES!

OUR PURPOSE: The CIDA mission is to encourage and promote all educational studies as well as historical and genealogical research that enhance the historical, cultural and civic significance of the accomplishments of the sixteen original Canary Islands families who founded the *Villa de San Fernando*, now the City of San Antonio. <u>http://www.cida-sa.org/purpose.html</u>. The CIDA Scholarship Program serves as a vehicle to fulfill this purpose by offering monetary scholarships to high school seniors.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS: Two scholarships <u>may</u> be awarded per year. One \$1200 scholarship may be awarded to a CIDA member (including junior members) and one \$1000 scholarship to a non-member.

AWARD DISTRIBUTION: Scholarships are awarded directly to the student after CIDA receives proof of college registration from the student. College (includes technical college) enrollment must in the following academic school year (2026-2027) to retain the award.

ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- High school seniors, including GED and home school students
 - o CIDA members from any geographical location (includes Junior members)
 - o Nonmember residents in <u>Bexar County and adjacent counties only</u>
- Minimum 3.0 GPA and submit official high school transcript
- > A fully completed and signed application form
- > Two-part essays double spaced, Times New Roman 12pt font and 1" margins
 - Part 1- Describe how your academic interest relates to or is inspired by the Canary Islanders history, genealogy, culture or civic significance (500-750 words). See <u>http://www.cida-sa.org</u>
 - **Part 2** Explain your community service involvement and what you learned from it.
- Two recommendation letters by educators, clergy or civic leader who is familiar with the applicant (original signature)
- You may complete the application electronically, print and mail with the required documentation, or you can print the application and then complete it manually. Please be sure your handwriting is legible.

APPLICATION TIMEFRAMES

- Students may start applying immediately
- Students must submit a complete application with essays, recommendation letters and school transcript and be postmarked not later than October 24, 2025. Incomplete applications <u>will not</u> be considered.
- Award recipients will be notified by February 15, 2026.
- Recipients will be announced at the CIDA Arrival Luncheon held in March 2026, and recipients will receive a courtesy ticket to the luncheon.
